

Antianthe expansa (Germar)

Length: 7-10 mm

Width between humeral angles: 5-8 mm

Height of crest: 4-7 mm

Regional distribution:

The genus *Antianthe* is primarily neotropical ranging from Mexico to Brazil and Bolivia as well as the Caribbean Islands. Populations of *A. expansa* have been found in southern Arizona and California. We are aware of one confirmed specimen from Florida (University of New Hampshire collection).

Seasonal distribution in FL:

unknown; UNH specimen collected 2 April 1947

Host associations in FL:

unknown; elsewhere on solanaceous plants including tomato and eggplant

Relative abundance in FL:

rare
