Seasonal distribution in FL:

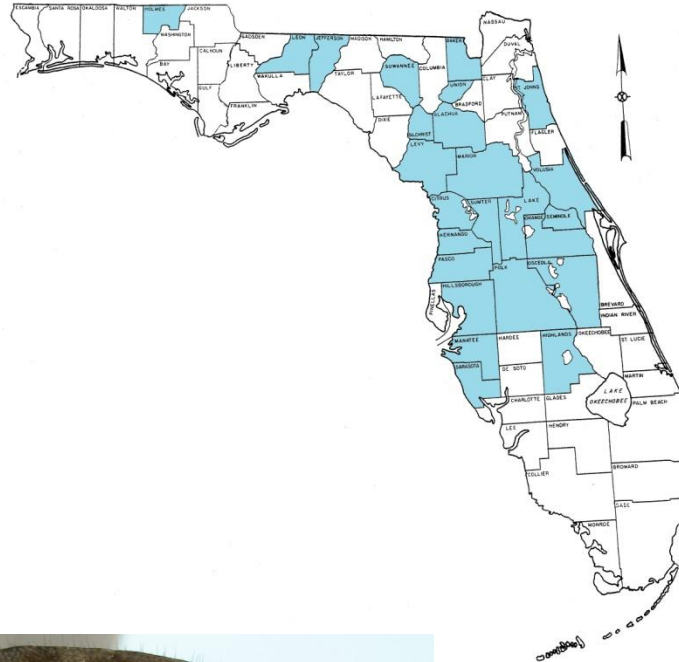
12 March-18 June;
